Benefits – Our AP Courses provide the opportunity to explore interests at a deeper level, develop academic skills, and access college level work while in high school.

Open Enrollment – Any student who meets the pre-requisites can register for an Advanced Placement course

Students – Each year, over 500 students participate in our AP program

Faculty – Many AP teachers have graduate degrees and/or National Board Certification

AP Capstone – Jordan is one of only two schools in DPS who offers the Capstone Program, a two-year program which provides opportunities for research and presentation.

The Advanced Placement Program at Jordan provides more than 20 AP courses to challenge & enrich students while preparing them for pursuits after high school. Courses are available every year and carry an additional weight of 1.0 for the grade point average. Additionally, students who earn qualifying scores on AP exams have the potential to earn college credit.
